Is one week too long? If a shorter camp of three nights is more manageable, try our Intermediate Camp filled with fun and excitement.

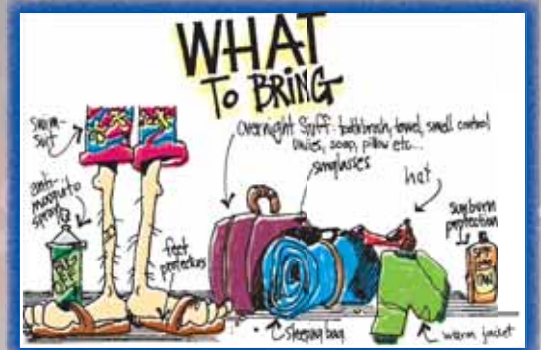
