

Celebrations:

- Attended the Deanery meeting in January and Deanery Faith-Sharing Day in March.
- Attended and participated in the Archdiocesan Camps Working Retreat in February and online meeting in October.
- We continue building a working relationship with the Archdiocese of Regina Youth Ministry team, NET, and CCO.
- Active membership with Saskatchewan Camps Association (SCA) participating in bi-weekly zoom meetings and webinars from March August.





- As we all will remember for many years to come, the province of SK went into a state of emergency lockdown on March 20 due to the growing international COVID-19 pandemic. This situation was ever-evolving and lasted for the remainder of the year and into 2021.
- The Board initially suspended hiring & programming plans throughout the spring, eventually cancelling the 2020 camper season in June due to the continuing provincial government state of emergency restrictions. All camper registrations were refunded.

We do many things well at camp but physical distancing might not be one of them! So until we can meet again...





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- Many discussions were had regarding how to minister to the camp family online...along with many "if we can" vs "should we" Board discussions through the many stages as the pandemic progressed.
- It was discussed and decided by Finance not to access available Federal COVID-relief funding programs.
- Gratitude to Caterina Eremondi, former team member from Saskatoon, for volunteering to create and deliver faith-based videos over 8 weeks throughout the summer. We offered this online programming via our camp website and Facebook account. Camp care packages were mailed out to all the 10 campers involved near the end of the summer.
- Unable to host our Annual Fish Fry fundraiser in person in July, we challenged supporters to consider donating to our Online Fish Fry Fundraiser in Sept...thank you to all who made donations!
- The Board met six (6) times this year via Conference Calls & AGM Meeting with email & Flocknote often used for communication between Conference Calls.
- We continue to use Flocknote for email/texting communications with camp family, Canva for graphic design, and Regpack to take & manage camper/fall retreat registrations both before, during, and after the season.
- Grateful for all those that financially donated during our pandemic season keeping us operating to minister in future seasons.

Challenges:

- 70th Anniversary discussions tabled during COVID-19 pandemic season.
- Applied but did not receive any Canada Summer Jobs Grant Program funding.
